Project details: Sustainable Healthcare in the primary care curriculum

We are looking for one enthusiastic medical student in Year 3 or above with an interest in sustainable healthcare and medical education to join our department.

The climate crisis is now widely recognised as a global health crisis. With growing awareness of the environmental footprint of healthcare, medical schools are being called on to incorporate sustainability into their curricula and equip future doctors to deliver environmentally responsible care. The Undergraduate Primary Care Education Unit has been reviewing the primary care curriculum for areas where approaches to sustainable healthcare can be developed.

We feel this is an ideal opportunity for a student shaper to partner with us. The student shaper would have the opportunity to be involved in a range of activities including a literature review, review of the current approaches to sustainable healthcare in the primary care curriculum, co-creation of guidance, teaching materials, faculty development materials and development of evaluation strategies. We will provide support throughout for this project with regular check ins. Our department has previously partnered with student shapers on many projects and achieved considerable success.

Our new student shaper will have an opportunity to engage in creating meaningful change in embedding approaches to sustainable healthcare within the primary care undergraduate curriculum. They will develop their skills in teamworking, leadership, communication and project management skills as they become a part of our educational team.

We are looking for a student to commit **3 hours a week** over **16 weeks**, starting as soon as possible.
